Environmental Policy Statement

Humber Work Boats Ltd is a privately owned British Company with almost forty years' experience of specialist Marine and dredging contracting. Based at North Killingholme the Company owns and operates from a purpose built three and a half acre facility on the banks of the River Humber.

Humber Work Boats has created a division to build and repair small boats and multi cats at its North Killingholme premises. Humber Work Boats utilises the 3.5-acre site and 10,000 sq. ft. workshop for the construction, repair or conversion of small and medium-sized vessels, with work being done on the quayside or in the workshop as appropriate. Boats for repair will be lifted out of and placed back in the water by the company's own heavy lift crane barges.

Humber Work Boats Limited acknowledges its contribution, as a consumer of resources, to the growing global environmental burden and recognises its responsibility to future generations by undertaking business practices that promote sustainable development.
